Sara Colman is a composer, singer-songwriter and educator.

Sara is co-director of the Jazzlines Summer School, Recording-Artist-in Residence at the Royal Birmingham Conservatoire and on the teaching faculty of both RBC and Guildhall School of Music and Drama, teaching jazz vocal and songwriting.

Sara has released two acclaimed recordings with Stoney Lane Records; *What We're Made Of* (2018) and *Ink On A Pin: A Celebration of Joni Mitchell* (2020)

Sara works closely with pianist and composer Rebecca Nash; the duo are currently preparing to release an album on Stoney Lane Records entitled *Ribbons*.

Sara has worked with some of the leading lights in British music including Laura Mvula, Liane Carroll and Mahalia and has made numerous festival appearances (Cheltenham, Manchester, Mostly Jazz, Sligo.) Sara also appeared as 'featured vocalist 'with The National Youth Jazz Orchestra of Scotland at the BBC Prom Night at The Royal Albert Hall.
